7- MANAGEMENT CARRIED OUT AND STRATEGIC PLAN IN THE FIELD OF THE CENTER AND SOUTH AMERICAN FEDERATION OF TAEKWON-DO ITF

As I stated in the last meeting we had in February, the plan for this area of the American Continent is based on the institutionalization and/or legalization of the Associations or Federations of each member country of the ITF, which I have already started in the year 2008 in Bolivia. Without forgetting my country's Federation, which achieved its official recognition by the Government of the Republic of Paraguay in 2001, together with the trademark registration.

First of all, I would like to remind you of the achievements made through the visits and advice given to the leaders of different countries in this region. The second country I visited for these purposes was Uruguay, where through Mr. Gabriel Colina, a unification agreement was reached between the



different ITF Taekwon-Do technical lines in that country, achieving Uruguay's recognition of its government as a legal entity (Uruguay N.A.).

In the same way I have done in Chile with the same results, that through its Federation it is recognized legally and officially by the governing body sports of its country (today FECHITAT N.A.). Also, in Peru I managed to bring together the leaders of three technical lines, Mr. Tulio Flores, Miguel López Astete, Jorge Ferrari and Andrés Peñasquez, who signed an agreement in principle of good coexistence with the objective of uniting before a single organization, which was not achieved but is still in process.

Also, in the same way, I visited Venezuela, whose leader at that time was Mr. Juan Martinez where we have not achieved positive results and where we are initiating a new contact. What started in Bolivia in 2008, had its good results through a Federation, whose leader is currently Ms. Verónica Varinia, which is in the process of recognition by the Government with very good management and appreciating the support by GM Pablo Trajtenberg who through his cousin, who is a very influential person in that country, found support in said management, also economically, achieving the first participation of competitors and referees from Bolivia in the last World Cup in Ireland.

In 2010, I started the legalization and recognition of the Central and South American Federation of Taekwon-Do ITF by the National Secretariat of Sports of the Republic of Paraguay, achieving this recognition and legalization on October 10, 2011, whose documentation was sent and it's on the ITF file.

Making an account of the situation of said Continental Federation, it happened that after having left the presidency of said Federation, whose successor was Master Raul Sanchez; for lack of presentations of Assembly minutes we lost the official status for not complying with these requirements whose management should be developed by the president in office.

I want to give you the good news that a matter of a week ago in a meeting with the Minister of Sport and the Legal Counsel of the Secretary of State, we have recovered the official and active status of the Federation, which makes me very happy, as it is very important for us that we are in search of recognition by SportAccord.

The situation in Argentina, as you already know, the Federation (FETRA) has lost its legal status for which, GM Pablo Trajtenberg has initiated the relevant procedures for the formation of a new Federation that has already had a favorable view. However, we have the Federación Misionera de Taekwon-Do ITF, legally recognized by the Province of Misiones (northern Argentina) and it is in the national registries of sports entities of the Argentine Republic, of which GM Pablo Trajtenberg is a titular member. The clear objective in that country is to unify under a Federation all the legally constituted entities that exist in the country, with the purpose of having a single governing entity of our ITF Taekwon-Do.

STRATEGIC SUPPORT PLAN FOR THE COUNTRIES OF AMERICA (PROPOSAL)

- 1- There will be an Assembly of all the members of the countries of this region within the framework of the next Pan-American XIV to be held in the city of Santos, Brazil, on May 17, 18 and 19. With the clear objective of putting the TAEKWON-DO ITF FEDERATION CENTER AND SOUTH AMERICAN FEDERATION back into operation legally, making the election of new authorities and developing small projects to be carried out within this institution, beyond the current continental tournaments that are two events that take place every two years (which are the Pan-American Taekwon-Do Championship and the Central and South American Taekwon-Do Championship).
- 2- Provide the necessary support to the member countries, emphasizing the advice in the processing and legalization of the governing entities of the ITF Taekwon-Do of the countries that do not yet have it, and monitor the entities already recognized in their operation and in their objectives by visiting these countries at least once a year.



- 3- Taking advantage of this visit, perform seminars or training courses according to the needs or requests of each country.
- 4- Examine the higher graduations that cannot be examined by their leaders for lack of graduation, in cases of need. In such a way that they do not lose their antiqueness for the next promotion and avoid having to travel or specifically hire an examiner for each situation (there are many countries in this region that do not have the possibility of carrying out an IIC where they could be examined).
- 5- Take advantage of this opportunity to carry out marketing and publicity by visiting all the media that may favor the diffusion and promotion of our organization, such as newspapers, radios and television media as we have done in Bolivia with a very positive result in favor of the growth of the different schools or academies that make up the federation of Bolivia.

HOW TO ACHIEVE THIS GOAL:

My personal proposal, open to listen to ideas that can enrich this plan

- 1- That the ITF takes charge of the cost of the tickets that oscillate between U\$S 300 to 500 (American dollars).
- 2- That the Federation or Organization of the country to visit is in charge of the accommodation and food of the speaker, being able to organize a seminar with a minimum cost (only to cover the expenses indicated above).
- 3- My work is free, except in case of extra benefits that may exist.
